# AHSJ UNIFORM GUIDELINES GIRLS – Pre-K through Grade 1

## **Mondays-Required Full Dress Uniform**

Also required for concerts, picture day and some field trips (May also be worn Tuesday-Thursday)

- Plaid skirt, skort, or jumper
- White or red polo with logo long or short sleeve
- White, gray, black, or red tights or knee-high socks
- Black shoes, solid Mary Jane, loafer or other flat
- Black boots must be above the calf, no fringe, fur, straps, sweater knit, pom poms, or open heel (1" is fine)
- Sweaters and vests with logo, black, gray, white, or red (optional)
- Blazers with logo, black or gray (optional)
- Fleece vests or jackets with logo, must be solid black, gray, white, or red
- Hoodies are only allowed if they have a school logo

#### **Tuesdays-Thursdays**

- Plaid skirt, skort, or jumper
- Black dress pants
- White or red polo with logo long or short sleeve
- White or red turtleneck with logo long or short sleeve
- Black, white, gray, or red tights or knee-high socks
- Black shoes solid, Mary Jane, loafer or other flat
- Black boots must be above the calf, no fringe, fur, straps, sweater knit, pom poms, or open heel (1" is fine)
- Sweaters and vests with logo black, gray, white, or red (optional)
- Blazers with logo, black or gray (optional)
- Fleece vests or jackets with logo, must be solid black, gray, white, or red
- Hoodies are only allowed if they have a school logo

# **Fridays**

- Jeans (conservative, clean, no holes, large designs, or bling)
- AHSJ t-shirt or white or red polo with logo long or short sleeve
- Athletic shoes (with socks)
- Hoodies are only allowed if they have a school logo
- School hats (with logo) worn forward

## \*Pants may not be tucked into boots.

\*\*All outerwear worn in class must be AHSJ approved and contain the logo.
